
Mr. Suehiro Sakai (from hand-woven fabric workshop "Yu"), who had been through the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake, proposed this event. He said "Many vocational facilities were damaged directly or indirectly by the disaster in Kobe and had to shut down. No bazaar was held in the disaster area and there was no opportunity for them to sell their products.'

At the bazaar, they sold goods made in "Nanohana Home" (Fukushima City), "Workshop Asunaro" (Koriyama City), and "Workshop Yu" (Shirakawa City). This event was held in partnership with NPO Charoom (Fukushima City), which has been familiar to Network Sanda for some time now.
